Consecutive Master's Study Programs

Consecutive Master's study programs build on a Bachelor's study program.

- They require prior knowledge from the Bachelor's study program.
- If this is not fully met, additional requirements and/or conditions may be imposed upon admission. These are Bachelor's modules to be completed.
- Additional requirements can be completed during the Master's study program.
- In the case of admission with conditions, Master's modules can only be booked once the conditions have been fulfilled.

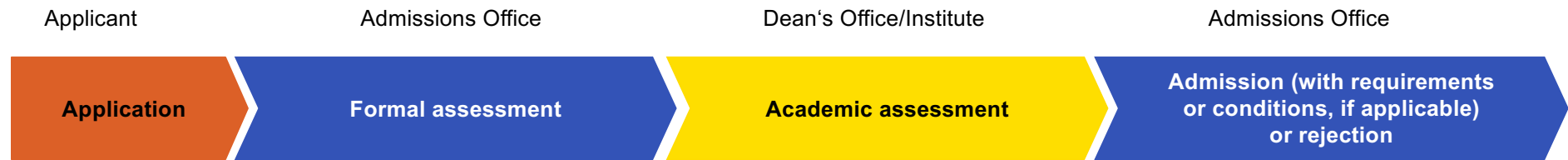

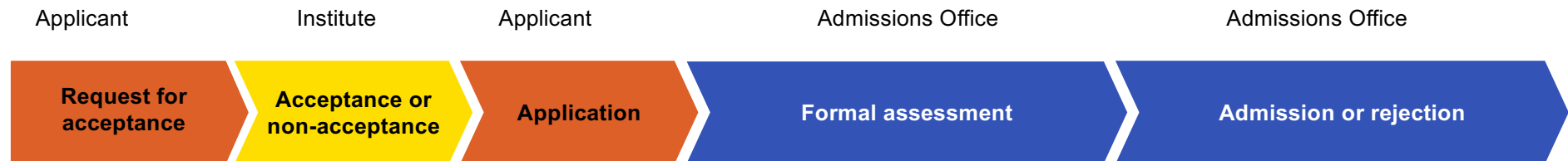


Non-Matriculated Students: Application in the Application Portal

Deadlines

The deadlines are mandatory. Some documents can be submitted later.

Deadlines for requests to change degree and study programs for matriculated students:

May 15 to August 31 for the fall semester

November 15 to January 31 for the spring semester

Application deadlines for non-matriculated students (special deadlines, if you need a visa):

January 1 to April 30 for the fall semester

July 1 to November 30 for the spring semester
